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Introduction

Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) is a term that encompasses two main chronic conditions: Ulcerative Colitis (UC) and Crohn's Disease (CD). Both UC and CD are characterized by inflammation of the gastrointestinal tract, but they differ in the location and nature of the inflammation.

Ulcerative Colitis (UC):

UC primarily affects the colon and rectum, leading to inflammation and the formation of ulcers on the inner lining of the colon. The exact cause of IBD is not well understood but is believed to involve a complex interplay of genetic, environmental, and immune system factors. Triggers for IBD may include a combination of genetic predisposition, an abnormal immune response, and environmental factors.

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Management of IBD typically involves a combination of medications, lifestyle modifications, and, in some cases, surgery. Medications may include anti-inflammatory drugs, immunosuppressants, biologics, and symptom-specific medications. Lifestyle modifications may involve dietary changes, stress management, and regular exercise.






Treatment for Mild to Moderate Active Ulcerative Colitis






Diagnostic Approach for Crohn's Disease






Treatment for Mild to Moderate Active Ulcerative Colitis






Treatment Algorithm for Severe Ulcerative Colitis
